Designed before the pandemic, *Ola Space Dividers* are proving to be very relevant given today's social distancing concerns. Created for the Spanish company Ondarreta, designer Silvia Ceñal sought inspiration from the shape of waves, or *olas*, that rise from the Cantabrian Sea during San Sebastian winters. Easy to move around the room, *Ola* is flexible enough to isolate and privatise certain areas on the fly, much appreciated in an open office space setting.

Each panel can be used individually, or joined at the base and linked together by leather straps in modular fashion. Its simple yet very contemporary look appeals to both subdued work environments, funky workspaces, or even in a home setting. Panels can be upholstered in fabrics of different colours, and also can be accessorised with document holders, storage units and coat hangers.

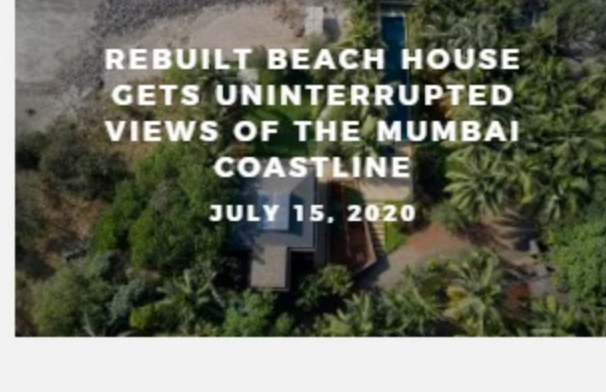
